This Sunday is Valentine's Day – what will this day hold for you? Perhaps it may be a time of celebrating the love of those who are part of your life (socially distanced in many cases!) as well as remembering those no longer with you? What about using this day to also reflect on God's amazing love for you?

In 1 John 4:7, we read *Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God.* This tells us that love is 'a God invention' because it comes from Him. Not only that, but later on in verse 16, we are told that *God is love* – in other words, His whole being is love.

This means there is no limit to His love – we cannot 'out love' God and what is more, He has shown the world just how much He loves everyone by sending His Son to be an atoning sacrifice for our sins (verse 10).

In response we are called not just to love God with all of our being too, but we are also called to love each other as we love ourselves – we are called to love both vertically and horizontally! He, who has spared nothing in making His love known to us, calls us to love as He loves.

So do you want to live life to the full today? Do you want to make a difference in the world? The answer is to love as God loves. What will your response be?
