This country is hosting two important international meetings this year, the G7 summit in Cornwall next week and COP26, the United Nations Climate Change Conference, in Glasgow in November. Is this just an event for politicians, or should we as Christians be interested too?

As Christians we love God who made and loves this world and the creatures and people who live in it. The Bible teaches us to take care of the earth, so when we realise that the way we're using the earth is damaging natural processes, causing the extinction of thousands of species and suffering to both creatures and people around the world, then we need to respond.

At its last meeting, our PCC recognised that we face a global environmental crisis, and that we must change our habits and practices. That is why we have encouraged the Creation Care Team over the past year to develop our environmental programme. We are looking at the way we use our land and buildings, how we can adopt greener life-styles, and how we can encourage our community in Eaton Socon and beyond. We are delighted that, like over 1000 other churches in the country, our programme has just been approved for the Eco Church bronze award.

We are marking this Sunday as 'Climate Sunday', when our worship will focus on creation, and how we can respond to the current crisis. The PCC has added its name to a petition to the Prime Minister asking him to act ahead of COP26, and it would be great if you added your name too. The PCC has also written to Jonathan Djanogly MP (see the letter on our website). Perhaps you would like to write to your MP as well. St Paul, in writing to Timothy, encourages us to pray for our government. We can all do this as it prepares to lead this conference in November, praying that it will do so with wisdom, resolve, integrity and generosity.
