All of us should be able to identify with this attitude because it's an attitude prevalent throughout humanity and time, including the lives of those we read of in Scripture. Using Acts 6, Julie helped us understand that when we face conflict in our churches like the early Church did (and we will), it is essential that we deal with it 'head on' and find solutions. If we don't, then people will simmer and fester, leading to even bigger challenges. Acts 6 teaches us that addressing conflict enables the Church to go from strength to strength.

However, as Julie reminded us on Sunday: All followers of the Lord Jesus Christ are in full-time Christian ministry—none of us are exempt.
