

Dear all,

What did Monday 19th July mean for you? Dubbed 'Freedom Day', Monday was the day that signalled the ending of the social restrictions in England. Yet in many ways, it isn't the end because the rising number of infections (but lower deaths) is still a concern for many – as such we need to ensure that St Mary's continues to be a place that people feel safe visiting. So what changes have we made?

- Hand Sanitiser will still be available as you enter the church and everyone is encouraged to make use of this
- **Face coverings** will no longer be required, however if people wish to wear one, you can. There will continue to be a supply of these available.
- Our 'Track & Trace' system will continue to the end of August, so people will still book in as usual or have their name and contact details taken at the door.
- If you wish to **keep the seat beside you free** to give you the space you feel most comfortable with, Red/White coloured 'Cross Cards' will be available.
- The current **Church Seating spacing** will remain (i.e. socially distanced) and will be reviewed in September.
- The **one-way system** will continue to be used and reviewed in September.
- **Singing in Church** either with or without masks is now allowed please consider those around you when singing (i.e. do avoid 'Football style singing!')
- **Holy Communion** will continue to be administered using the disposable individual sets that will be brought to your seat.

We hope that all these measures will help everyone to feel safe when visiting St Mary's. If you have any questions, please do contact me.
