



St Mary's Clock Restoration Appeal £2634.

Please help to restore the church clock and hear the unique chimes once again. As part of the church building, it adds to the feature of Eaton Socon Green.

The clock is nearly 100 years old and has a distinctive and unique sounding chime which can be heard throughout Eaton Socon. The chime was actually composed by Mr S G Wilkinson, a local solicitor who had won a competition. But sadly, it has stopped working and is in need of remedial work and a service.

An expert has looked at it and found that the rewind motor on the time side of the clock is working inconsistently and the switching mechanism is not operating correctly; both need to be repaired.

The clock face will also receive attention; painting and sealing the numerals and hands.

The quoted repair cost is £2634.

Many people perceive that St Mary's Church receives finances from government or outside sources. This is not the case. All running costs are met by the generosity of the congregation and those who wish to give. Unfortunately, St Mary's does not have the funds to pay for this work as the priority is for pastoral and mission work.
